

Dear members and friends of St. John's,

Two and one-half years ago, I made a deal for a brand new Toyota Corolla. I love everything about my car from its smooth ride, to its comfortable seats (perfect for long trips to Vermont to see my kids), to its peppy little engine that roars like a little lion, and its great gas mileage.

A Sirius Satellite Radio was "thrown in" as part of the deal. Somewhere up in heaven I could hear my father, who always negotiated floor mats as his throw-ins saying, "That's my boy."

One of the other models I considered was a Prius. It is Toyota's version of the hybrids that are becoming more commonplace with their gasoline and electric engines, each of which can propel them.

This hybrid will provide many and varied chances to experience worship and fellowship as one congregation. Since this schedule will remain in place through the end of October, you will be able to take each model for a test drive.

Just stop and think about it. God has handed us the keys to this once in a generation opportunity to invest in something with that brand shiny new car look and feel.

As your pastor, all I am asking from you are two things. As you try out these different elements, give Jeff Conner, our Church and Ministry Chairperson, Julie Kroah, our Christian Education Director and Media Coordinator and me your feedback. This will help us make the worship experience better and more meaningful for you!

While you're doing all of these things, remember that it is Jesus Christ who propels this hybrid model. If we put our faith and trust in Jesus by continuing to build on his sure foundation, this latest chapter in the history of our church will surely be a great success for generations to come!

Treasurer's Report: Frank Davis

As of April 25th, Faith Promise giving is \$3723.00 ahead for the year, and expenses are \$4061.87 less than budgeted for the year.


